'Extreme painters' coat 140-foot Greeley water tower

The summer sun beat down on Rich Purnell just a little bit harder than everywhere else in Greeley. From atop a 140-foot water tower in west Greeley recently, Purnell surveyed two of his employees as they dangled over 20th Street and coated the tower with fresh paint. For Purnell, it was another day at work. The owner of BASE Group in Arvada, Purnell and company paint hundred-foot-high industrial and commercial structures from perspectives that few other people have seen. It's a specialized
